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School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes

October 27, 2011

Call to Order:

The SAC meeting was called to order by Mrs. Martin, at 5:00 p.m. with words of welcome and a request for the reading and approval of the last minutes. Motioned by Mrs. Hardin and seconded by Mrs. Waldrop to approve. Minutes approved. Members present included:

Mr. King agreed to address these topics at the next meeting.

Fundraiser / Silent Auction:

Mrs. Hardin reported that the Bozard Ford Lincoln fundraiser (go to their Facebook page, “like” it, and post “Banking on Bucks” gives the school a \$2.50 donation) is progressing well. Tuesday, November 1, 2011 is the last day for the fundraiser. Donations are still coming in for the silent auction / spaghetti dinner scheduled for Thursday, 3 November from 6-7:30. We discussed using the Alert Now system to notify parents about the silent auction and spaghetti dinner. We also discussed contacting the St. Augustine Record and district Media Services to make the community aware of the events / happenings at SJTHS.

Parent Involvement Plan:

Mrs. Martin reported that a draft plan is in development for presentation at the November meeting.

SAC Business:

A request for \$40.00 for a SJTHS student’s enrollment fee in a guitar class was discussed. Mrs. Martin motioned that the SAC approved the funding and Mrs. Hardin seconded the motion; no dissent. We discussed a proposal from the Reading Department to use \$200.00 in SAC funds to purchase I-tunes cards to use as student rewards. Mr. King motioned approval and Mrs. Waldrop seconded the motion; no dissent. As an effort to increase parent involvement, we reviewed a proposal for \$150.00 for post cards with postage. These “positive postcards” would allow teachers to communicate to parents the positive encounters with their students. Ms. McGeever motioned approval and Mrs. Hardin seconded the motion; no dissent.
