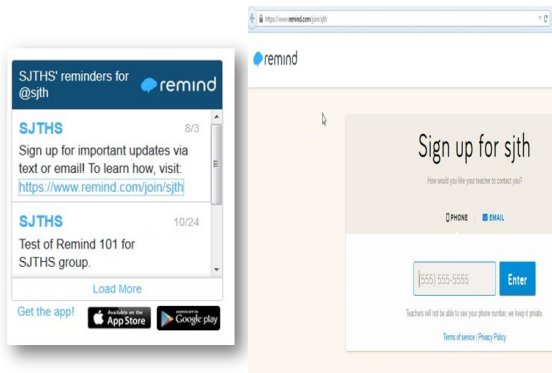
8th Grade Parent Night
