1. Exceeded our expectations!

- a. 80% pass rate on the Algebra EOC & _____ increase on the Civics EOC.
- b. The dropout rate decreased from 5.2% to 3.5% and the student attendance rate increased from 88.5% to 90%.
- c. Increased Enrollment 17%: Reaching more at-risk students in St. Johns County.

2. Disparities/Challenges!

- a. Students lack the fundamental reading and writing skills to meet the demands of a new, more rigorous, FSA assessment. 6th grade
- b. 47% of our 8th graders are split grade levels (17% for all middle school)
- c. 61% of our students have been retained at least once in St. Johns County Schools (of that 16% have been retained 3 or 4 times)

3. Goals to address Disparities/Challenges!

- a. Identify needs during “Summer Bridge Camp” and provide services during Extended Learning remediation w/ transportation provided
- b. Monthly Progress Monitoring (Which includes weekly targeted small group instruction to differentiate learning needs), also providing 1st Time Credit & Credit Recovery to allow students to get to grade level
- c. Academic Support Services: AVID, Mentors for at risk students, mental health counselor, guidance counselor, and social worker on site. (w/Lunch Bunch)
