## What is Title I?

Title I is a federal program designed to offer <u>supplemental</u> services and supplies to schools with a high rate of poverty.

The goal of Title I is to give *EVERY* child a highquality education.

## Importance of Title I

Title I can help:

• Children be more successful in school

- Parents to have a voice in their child's education
- Teachers to collaborate with parents to assist their child's education



# The Basics of Title I

The Title I program starts with:

• The Federal Government

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- They provide funds to the states each year for Title I after the state sends a plan in detailing:
  - What children know and should be able to do
  - High- quality standards that children are expected to meet
  - Ways that student progress will be measured

## The Basics of Title I

The Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) receives the money from the Federal Government.

- The Florida Department of Education will then send the money to the districts based on the number of families that receive free and reduced lunches
- Once the Local School District receives the money from the State
  - The Local School District then identifies eligible schools and distributes the funds

The Title I schools, the parents, administrators, teachers and staff devise a plan to:

- Identify students who need the most help
- Measure student progress using the state standards
- Develop programs that help to supplement classroom instruction

# Programs Offered by Title I

Title I offers programs to help student achievement such as:

- Extra time for instruction
- Various teaching methods and materials

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
### Carlisle Interconnect Technologies Manufacturing Internship



- Juniors and Seniors move through three tiers of training: Orientation to Manufacturing, Classroom Instruction, and paid On-the-Job Training
- Student interns matched with Carlisle employees to complete 3 job rotations
- Learning targets: Manufacturing basics, LEAN manufacturing, engineering, OSHA safety, precision measurement, product quality, production control and inventory, maintenance, shipping/receiving


